OPEN CALL FOR YOUNG TALENTS

The REVIVE project partners are inviting young creative minds to explore how cultural heritage can inspire communities in developing new sustainable living models.

Becoming a member of a multidisciplinary international creative team is a great opportunity to learn, explore, co-create and test innovative solutions for reviving old historical towns and sites.

During REVIVE project, this is being achieved through **physical and virtual experimentation** in four selected specific urban sites, each facing their own challenges common to many cities, towns and villages across Europe: **Tržič (Slovenia)**, **Turku (Finland)**, **Cellino Attanasio (Italy)**, **lași (Romania)**.

We are now looking for young talents to become part of creative teams for live experiments taking place next year. We invite you to stay for two weeks in the following cities:

- Cellino Attanasio, Italy, from 30th of March until 12th of April &
- lasi, Romania, from 10th to 25th of May 2025

In Cellino Attanasio, the project intervention will focus on a former unused theatre space in the historical centre, with the aim to convert it into a multi-functional and multi-generational space available for creation, design and implementation of new cultural and artistic content to help revive the community.

In Iaşi, the experiment will take place in the Palace of Culture and its challenging underground space of industrial heritage which is to become a space for cross-cultural exchanges, involving individuals and communities from different nationalities who have over the centuries found home and prosperity in Iaşi.

Apart from the onsite experiments, the selected young talents are required to participate in the preparatory online activities:

- a joint online Bootcamp divided in two parts (to learn more about the location, meet the relevant stakeholders as well as the other team members, brainstorm and start co-creating initial solutions for the site)
- a transnational online capacity building event (to learn and get inspired from good practice examples).





These will be organised prior to each experiment. Additional (non-obligatory) online mentorship meetings could be added depending on the needs.

This call is for you if:

- you are between 18 and 30 years old;
- you live in (or you are a national of) Slovenia, Finland, Italy, Croatia, Romania or Spain. Note: apart from travelling to experiments to other countries you can also participate in the experiment in your own country.
- you are a student or a recent graduate in the following fields: architecture, cultural heritage, restoration, visual or performing arts, history, anthropology, urbanism, landscape planning, communication, digital media, ecology, civil engineering...or any related fields that you believe the project would benefit from;
- you are open-minded with interest in other cultures;
- you have a good level of written and spoken English;
- you are able to commit to the project and travel to the onsite experiments during the above mentioned dates as well as to participate in the online preparatory activities.

How to apply?

- Fill in the google form: https://forms.gle/mo37WDb10cx7gXSR7 and upload your CV and a portfolio (if you have one not obligatory). In the form, you are required to explain how you could contribute to the project and in which experiment you would like to participate. It is possible to participate in more than one experiment. Therefore, those who participated in experiments in Slovenia and Finland are also eligible to apply as well as those who want to join both experiments in Italy and Romania.
- Deadline for submission of application: 27th of September 2024

What do you get?

- Valuable international experience in cultural heritage revitalisation
- Opportunity to learn from others and build your capacity in the field
- Travel costs to site as well as basic accommodation and food covered during the 2 weeks long onsite experiment
- Certificate of participation and possible recommendation letters for your future projects and applications.

Evaluation process:

Received applications will be revised between 30th of Septebmer and 13th of
 October 2024 by each of the project partners in their own countries who will

create a pre-selection list. The final team composition for each experiment is jointly decided by all partners.

- Successful candidates will be informed at the latest by 15th of October 2024.
- The first online Bootcamps are planned for the following dates:
 23rd of October 2024 for the experiment in Italy
 6th of November 2024 for the experiment in Romania
